Telephone Interpretation Services

Telephone interpretation is a three-way phone conversation with a human interpreter. This service is available 24/7, Call 501-526-0399 and provide the following information: Caller's name, Building: UA-Fayetteville, Location/BU Code: (OEOC, TRST, etc)



Video Remote Interpreting
